**Page 10:** "KORYO KOREAN" - 6<sup>th</sup> Bullet "Troops marked \* ....." DELETE entire bullet.

**Page 11:** TABLE "KORYO KOREAN" – Remove the \* from the first 4 entries in the "total Bases" column.

"Hang-ma-gun" – points per base: REPLACE "5" with "6"

"Levy 'spearmen and archers" "Total Bases" REPLACE "20-56" with "10-40"

**Page 12:** TABLE "KORYO KOREAN ALLIES" "Hang-ma-gun" – points per base: REPLACE "5" with "6"

Levy 'spearmen' and Levy archers – DELETE both entries.

**Page 23:** TABLE "MEDIEVAL SPANISH AND PORTUGUESE ALLIES" Crossbowmen-Only before 1150AD: [DELETE](#) entire entry

**Page 26 & 27:** TABLES "LATE HEIAN TO MUROMACHI JAPANESE" and "ALLIES" Bushi and detached bushi – "Total Bases" (36-84) ..... Split into 4 sections as follows:

**Page 94:** TABLE “LATER POLISH” Core troops – Total Bases, DELETE “46-48”. Use “Total Bases” entries for individual troop types.

**Page 95:** TABLE “LATER POLISH ALLIES” Core troops – Total Bases, DELETE “8-24”. Use “Total Bases” entries for individual troops types.

**Page 98:** “MEDIEVAL SCANDINAVIAN” 3<sup>rd</sup> bullet, ADD “or Swedish allied contingents” before “must have”.

**Page 105:-** TABLE “CATALAN COMPANY”: Alan Allies – REPLACE “Book1: Alan Allies” with “Book2: Early Alan list”

**Page 105:-** TABLE “CONDOTTA ITALIAN ALLIES” REPLACE “Mercenary men-at-arms” with “Elmeti”

**Page 105:-** TABLE “LATER PLANTAGENET ENGLISH (CONTINENTAL) ALLIES” “English dismounted men-at-arms) “Bases per BG” REPLACE “4” with “4-6”

**Page 123:** “TUPI” ADD a 3<sup>rd</sup> Bullet:

- Warriors can be armed with Pole Arms or Heavy Weapons, but all bases in a battle group must be armed the same.
- TABLE “TUPI”: - Territory Types – ADD “Hilly”  
Troop commander: DELETE “0-3” MERGE both entries into one “0-2”. ADD Allied commander as follows:

**Page 133:-** “LATER HUNGARIAN ALLIES” “Light Horse”/ Combined “total Bases” DELETE entry containing “4-8”

**Page 135:-** “ORDONNANCE FRENCH ALLIES” “Ordonnance longbowmen” - “Total Bases” REPLACE “6-12” with “0-12”

**Page 136:-** “MAPUCHE OR ARAUCANIAN” Troops Notes – Last Sentence: “Neither can..”, REPLACE “cannot” with “can”.

**Page 136:-** “MAPUCHE OR ARAUCANIAN” “Spearmen” – “Total Bases”, REPLACE all (minimum) entries of “20” with “16”

**Page 143:** TABLE “ANATOLIAN TURCOMAN ALLIES” Light cavalry, Total Bases – REPLACE “6-18” with “4-18” (Twice).

**Page 144:** TABLE “CENTRAL AMERICAN ALLIES” “Calpolli foot”, Total bases – REPLACE “16-32” with “10-32”

**Page 145:** TABLE “EARLY SERBIAN ALLIES” “archers”, Total Bases – REPLACE “6-12” with “0-12”
